NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 05 of April 2022 at 0:15 at 11955 S APOPKA VINELAND RD (Zone: 51) in Orange County did

On April 6, 2022, at approximately 0050 hours, I met with Deputy Jacques at the Orange County Jail with the defendant, Victor Dubauskas, in reference to a battery viewed as a hate crime. As I began speaking with Victor, I asked about his vehicle that he reported stolen earlier in the day. The vehicle being stolen had no involvement with the battery. Victor gave me clear and concise answers and appeared to be in sound mind. I asked Victor about his overall health which he stated was fine. Victor said he is diagnosed with being bipolar and is currently taking medications. I asked when was he last evaluated, and Victor told me a few days ago. He did not need immediate medical attention. Upon meeting with Victor, I read him his Miranda Rights, in which he wished to speak to a lawyer. All questioning was immediately stopped in reference to the battery. The victim, Ghulam Shareef, is a Muslim male who was wearing traditional attire at the time of the battery. The attire consisted of a white shirt and white pants consistent with the culture with a navy blue jacket. Mr. Shareef was not wearing the same type of clothing as the individuals outside business at the time of the incident. Victor questioned the individuals about where they were from and their religion prior to the battery. Based on Victor's actions and questioning, it is clear Mr. Shareef was singled out based on his appearance and his religion. Victor also made the statement, "I have an issue with the Muslims sitting outside," prior the incident. As he left walked to his vehicle, Victor threw his Corona bottle in the direction of Mr. Shareef. As Victor got into his vehicle to leave, he told the group he was going to return and kill all of them. Victor then left at a high rate of speed northbound on Apopka Vineland Road. Victor was booked into the Orange County Jail without incident. The charge of battery was amended to add evidencing prejudice.
