KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

You may have the right to wear religious attire

• You may wear a hijab, kufi, abaya, thobe, etc.

You have the right to pray in school

- As long as it does not conflict with educational time, you may pray at school.
- Your school should provide you with a safe & clean space to pray in.

You may have the right to attend Jummah prayer

 As long as you communicate & create a leave of absence protocol with your school.

You have the right to observe religious holidays

• Notify the school of your religious holiday for an excused absence.

You have the right to be protected from bullying & harassment

• If someone makes offensive comments about Islam, makes fun of: your country of origin, religion, name, etc.— even in a joking way—report it to the administration.

 Be sure to communicate with your school in writing when you do need accommodations!
